

God's determining factor for making His presence your dwelling place for eternity is, *What have you done with Jesus Christ?*

And what is it that God has said? That he has given us eternal life, and that this life is in his Son. So whoever has God's Son has life; whoever does not have his Son, does not have life. — 1 John 5:11-12

Jesus Christ stands knocking at the door of your heart wanting in.

Look! I have been standing at the door and I am constantly knocking. If anyone hears me calling him and opens the door, I will come in and fellowship with him and he with me. — Revelation 3:20

So, where is Jesus Christ in your life—on the inside—or just on the outside? And, if He isn't on the inside, wouldn't you like to pray right now and get Him in?

Pray this *World's Most Important Prayer*, aloud, and from your heart:

...long to go and be with Christ. How much happier for me than being here. — Philippians 1:23b Jesus, using a symbolic analogy, says escaping Hell, and making Heaven for eternity, is so vitally important, that if our hand or foot were to lead us astray from getting there, we should cut that offending hand or foot off!

On the cross as full payment for our sins. When we ask Him to come into our hearts/lives as Savior and Lord, He writes our name in His Book of Life. Then, the moment we die, we are taken to Heaven until that glorious day when Jesus returns to earth, giving us a perfect and immortal body like the one He has now. The Apostle Paul, a notable Bible writer, who evidently had his own out of body visit to God's residence, Heaven (see 2 Corinthians 12:1-4), wrote:

sins. Wash me in your blood. Write my name in the Book of Life. Fill me with your Holy Spirit so I can serve and obey you. In Jesus' name, Amen.

How can I know for sure that God has heard my prayer, that He has come to live within me, and that I will spend eternity with Him? The Bible, which is God speaking to us, is backed by the reputation of God Himself. When we stand in faith on God's Word, He is faithful to fulfill His good promises. Thus, your assurance of Heaven rests on God's ability to keep His word.

...Your promises are backed by all the honor of your name. — Psalms 138:2b

Jesus Christ said, *And though all heaven and earth shall pass away, yet my words remain forever true.* — Luke 21:33

Dr. Ian Stevenson, a professor of psychiatry, studied NDEs & OBEs (near death and out of body experiences) for twenty years. In a Readers Digest article, *Life After Death* — *Growing Evidence*, he stated, "I think it prudent to prepare for the eventuality." Dr. Maurice Rawlings, in his bestselling book *Beyond Death's Door*, tells how he revived a postal worker who suffered cardiac arrest during a treadmill test in his office. Rawlings administered CPR. The patient would cry out, "Don't stop, don't stop! Don't you know that every time you stop, I die and go to Hell?" "Shut up and keep your hell to yourself until I get this pacemaker installed!" Rawlings had replied. The doctor had believed death to be painless extinction. His colleagues had told him that when people die, they become fertilizer for the flowers. Rawlings, shaken by this and other experiences, wrote, "I found out it may not be safe to die!"
