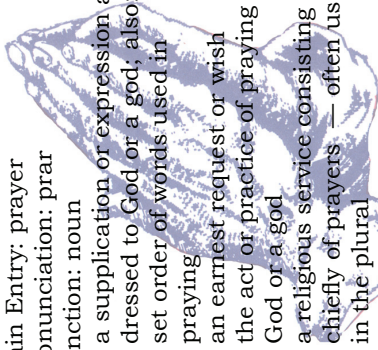

- Make us holy and blameless as we stand before God without a single fault. (John 1:24)

Pray this **World's Most Important Prayer**, aloud, and from your heart, right now:

*Dear Father God, I come before You in Jesus' name. Forgive me and cleanse me from all my sins, by the blood Jesus shed for me. Make me a child of God, writing my name in The Book of Life. Fill me with the Holy Spirit so I can serve*

- Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth. — 3 John 2 KJV
- The LORD says, I will rescue those who love Me. I will protect those who trust in My name. When they call on Me, I will answer; I will be with them in trouble. I will rescue and honor them. I will reward them with a long life and give them My salvation. — Psalm 91:14-16 NLT

- The **Most Important Prayer** will:
  - Make us a child of God. (Galatians 3:26)
  - Give us reservation for Heaven as our eternal destination by enrolling our name in God's Book of Life.
  - Rescues us from the kingdom of Satan and transfers us into the Kingdom of God's dear Son. (Revelation 3:5)
  - Separates our sins from us, as far as we are concerned. (Colossians 1:13)

*These miraculous signs will accompany those who believe: They will cast out demons in My name, and they will speak in new languages. They will be able to handle snakes with safety, and if they drink anything poisonous, it won't hurt them. They will be able to place their hands on the sick, and they will be healed.* — Mark 16:17-18 NLT (Jesus speaking)

God gave Jesus **the name above all other names** (Philippians 2:9). The Apostle Peter called Jesus the *Autor of life*, and explained the miracle healing of a crippled man like this: *Faith in Jesus' name has healed him before your very eyes.* — Acts 3:15-16 NLT

Using the name of Jesus in prayer, we have power and authority over evil forces and troubling circumstances. *And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to His purpose for them. What shall we say about such wonderful things as these? If God is for us, who can ever be against us? Since He did not spare even His own Son but gave Him up for us all, won't He also give us everything*

The Bible does not tell us to pray to Jesus. *Pray like this: Our Father in heaven...* — Matthew 6:9 NLT

**Bible Guidelines on Prayer:**

7. Things that can hinder or disrupt our prayer lives. (1 Peter 3:7)
8. Satan and demons try to block the answer. (Daniel 10:13-14)
9. The **Most Important Prayer** — the prayer by which we become a child of God, and receive eternal life as a free gift. (John 5:24)

## God's Word tells us about How to Pray:

1. To pray for everyone, about everything, and on every occasion. (1 Timothy 2:1)
2. Who to pray to. (Ephesians 3:14)
3. To pray in faith, believing we have received the answer when we pray. (Mark 11:24)
4. To ask according to God's will as revealed in the Bible. (1 John 5:14)
5. The best kind of prayer for the need or occasion. (Ephesians 6:18)
6. Assures us our prayers will be answered. (Matthew 18:19)

Pray according to God's will as revealed in the Bible.
