# The Two Kinds of Knowing

The French and Spanish languages have two separate verbs for the English infinitive “to know”: Fr. *Savoir, Connaître*; Sp. *Saber, Conocer*.

The first verb form means: to be able to, to know how, to be well aware of, to have at one’s fingertips.

The second means: understand, observe, perceive, be acquainted (with), confess, acknowledge, know carnally, know oneself, know one another, recognize someone by an attribute (e.g., voice).

The cover picture can be used to illustrate these two different meanings. If one is traveling by car in unfamiliar territory and sees only a ‘*Stop road closed*’ sign, he would likely believe as fact the advice of the unknown person who posted the sign, and attempt to find another route to his destination. A person who wants to forge ahead and come to his own conclusion—“I’ll believe it when I see it for myself!”, may ignore the sign and come to the previously unseen landslide

down the road. He would transition from *head knowledge* or *mental assent*, to a personal experience.

On a spiritual level, God programmed into humanity a desire or quest to find, know, experience God on a personal level. The Holy Bible, the Word of God, records Jesus Christ, the Son of God, praying to His Heavenly Father for each of us to also find and know God, and obtain eternal life with Him in the Heavenly Kingdom of God.

**John 17:3-25b NLT And this is the way to have eternal life—to know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, the One You sent to earth.**

“I am praying ... also for all who will ever believe in Me ...

“I pray that they will all be one, just as You and I are one—as You are in Me, Father, and I am in You. And may they be in Us...

“O righteous Father, **the world doesn't know You, but I do;...**”

**Being religious, and going to church may teach us *about* God. Through Christ, we too, like Jesus, can have a personal**

**and meaningful daily walk with our Creator**, becoming a child of the God Who is Love. We can be confident that we will spend our eternity with Him.

1 John 4:8b-10 NLT God is love. God showed how much He loved us by sending His one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through Him.

This is real love—not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins.

God wants each of us to have a personal *relationship* with Him. We didn't *know* Him because we left His ways to follow our own (Isaiah 53:6 NLT). Jesus lived a sinless life, then, voluntarily, paid the penalty for our sins by dying on a cross in our place for our sins, removing the barrier to our knowing and experiencing the Heavenly Father.

2 Corinthians 5:20-21 TLB We are Christ's ambassadors. God is using us to speak to you: we beg you, as though Christ himself were here pleading with you, receive the love he offers you—be reconciled to God. For God took the sinless Christ and poured

into him our sins. Then, in exchange, he poured God's goodness into us."

1 Timothy 2:3-6 TLB God...longs for all to be saved and to understand this truth: *That God is on one side and all the people on the other side, and Christ Jesus, himself man, is between them to bring them together, by giving his life for all mankind.*

Our creator did His part 2000 years ago, and now is waiting for us to respond, accepting and receiving forgiveness for our sins. Knowing God and the *free gift* of everlasting life can now be ours for the asking!

Titus 2:11 TLB For the free gift of eternal salvation is now being offered to everyone;

Titus 3:4-6 TLB But when the time came for the kindness and love of God our Savior to appear, then he saved us—not because we were good enough to be saved, but because of his kindness and pity—by washing away our sins and giving us the new joy of the indwelling Holy Spirit whom he poured out upon us with wonderful fullness—and all because of what Jesus

Christ our Savior did so that he could declare us good in God's eyes—all because of his great kindness; and now we can share in the wealth of eternal life he gives us, and we are eagerly looking forward to receiving it.

**We accept God's amazing offer of becoming a child of the King, through personal faith in Jesus as our Lord and Savior.**

Galatians 3:26 NLT For you are all children of God through faith in Christ Jesus.

Dear reader, Jesus is knocking at the door of your heart wanting in.

Revelation 3:20 NLT “Look! I stand at the door and knock. If you hear My voice and open the door, **I will come in**, and we will share a meal together as friends.”

Say “Yes!” by praying this **World's Most Important Prayer** aloud and from your heart:

*Dear Jesus, Come into my heart, forgive all my sins, wash me in Your blood, write my name in the Book of Life, fill me with the Holy Spirit so I can serve and obey You. In Jesus' name, Amen.*

**If You sincerely prayed this, God's Bible promises are your assurance He is now living in you, you are His child, and you will spend eternity with Him.**

John 1:12-13 TLB But to all who received him, he gave the right to become children of God. All they needed to do was to trust him to save them. All those who believe this are reborn!—not a physical rebirth resulting from human passion or plan—but from the will of God.

2 Corinthians 5:17 TLB When someone becomes a Christian he becomes a **brand new person** inside. He is not the same anymore. A new life has begun!

Romans 6:23 TLB For the wages of sin is death, but the **free gift** of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

1 John 5:25 TLB And he himself has promised us this: *eternal life*.

**We can grow in our newly found relationship with and understanding of God.**

Hosea 6:3 NLT “Oh, that we might know the LORD! Let us press on to know Him. He

will respond to us as surely as the arrival of dawn or the coming of rains in early spring.”

1. Read your Bible daily and obey it.  
Begin in the NEW testament.  
First, read the Gospel of John.
2. Pray & give thanks to your heavenly Father daily. Pray in Jesus' name.
3. Attend a Bible believing church.
4. Be baptized in water.
5. Share your faith. Let your love for Jesus bring others to Him.
